## 5. POLICIES

#### Behaviour and Code of Conduct

- Campers at George Brown College are members of a complex community and, as such, are required to obey the laws of the country, the province and the city; to observe the rules of the college; and to conduct themselves within commonly accepted standards of behaviour. The college is committed to providing a safe, respectful and inclusive learning and working environment for everyone.
- Dishonesty, misconduct, disruption of the academic environment, destruction of property, fraud, misdemeanours, other offences against persons or things, failure to abide by the various regulations of the institution or failure to respect the rights of others either in person or online cannot be tolerated in the George Brown College community, which is dedicated to the development of mature and responsible individuals.
- Campers are responsible for their own actions at all times. Ignorance of the rules or of the law is not a defence against disciplinary action. Lack of intention to violate college policy will not generally excuse an infraction.
- Individuals posing a risk of harm to others in the classroom, elsewhere on campus or in the context of a field trip will be expelled from the program. No refund will be given.

## Health and Safety

- Each individual within the college community shares in the responsibility of sustaining a safe and healthy environment. To promote the health and safety of students and staff as well as the cleanliness of the buildings, George Brown College has adopted firm rules regarding its campuses. These include no animals (except for Service Animals) and no in-line skates (such as Rollerblades), bicycles or other vehicles in college buildings. (All campuses have approved bicycle storage areas.)
- In accordance with City of Toronto By-law No. 23-88 and the Smoke-free Ontario Act, George Brown College is a smoke-free
  environment.

### **Lunch and Breaks**

- Campers will have a one-hour lunch period and two 15-minute breaks each day. There are no food facilities within the building, but campers who wish to bring a packed lunch will have access to our on-site lunchroom, which has both a fridge and a microwave. Camp staff will also be able to provide supervision for campers who need to go off-site to purchase their lunch.
- The parent/legal guardian of a camper can grant approval for that camper to go off-site unaccompanied for lunch and breaks. This must be done as part of the waiver.

## Supervision

• George Brown College and the School of Makeup and Esthetics does **not** guarantee supervision for campers outside of camp hours (9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.). However, the building is open from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., so campers who arrive before camp starts or need to stay after camp ends are welcome to wait in the lunchroom. The camp classroom will open 30 minutes before camp starts.

#### Withdrawals and Refunds

- If a camper wishes to withdraw from the Special Effects Makeup Camp at the George Brown College School of Makeup and Esthetics, the camper must officially withdraw no later than four weeks before the first day of camp. To officially withdraw, a withdrawal request must be sent to makeup@georgebrown.ca and must include the camper's name, the camper's student ID number, the class section course registration number (CRN) and the reason for withdrawal.
- If a camper withdraws at least four weeks before the first day of camp, the college will provide a full refund less \$20. If a camper withdraws later than four weeks before the first day of camp, the college will **not** provide a refund.
